## WHAT DOES INTERFIRST INSURANCE GROUP LLC DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

<b>Why?</b>	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
<b>What?</b>	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Social Security number and employment information</li> <li>■ Property Information and credit history</li> <li>■ Insurance rates and insurance claims</li> </ul>
<b>How?</b>	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Interfirst Insurance Group LLC chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

## Who we are

### Who is providing this notice?

This notice is provided by Interfirst Insurance Group LLC for its customers.

## What we do

### How does Interfirst Insurance Group LLC protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

### How does Interfirst Insurance Group LLC collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you

- Apply for an insurance policy or give us your contact information
- Provide employment or give us income information
- Provide property information

We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, and other companies

### Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only

- Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness
- Affiliates from using your information to market to you
- Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for information on your rights under state laws.

### What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?

Your choices will apply to you only, unless you tell us otherwise.

## Definitions

### Affiliates

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Our affiliated include:

- ***Interfirst Mortgage Company***
- ***United Settlement Services, LLC***

### Nonaffiliates

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- ***Interfirst Insurance Group LLC does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.***

### Joint marketing

A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- ***Interfirst Insurance Group LLC does not jointly market.***

## Other important information

**Do Not Call Policy.** This notice is the Interfirst Insurance Group LLC Do Not Call Policy under the Telephone Consumer Protection Act. We do not solicit via telephone numbers listed on the state or federal Do Not Call lists, unless the law allows. Interfirst Insurance Group LLC employees receive training on how to document and process telephone marketing choices. Consumers who ask not to receive telephone solicitations from Interfirst Insurance Group LLC will be placed on the Interfirst Insurance Group LLC Do Not Call list and will not be called in future campaigns, including those of Interfirst Insurance Group LLC affiliates.

**Call Monitoring and Recording.** If you communicate with us by telephone, we may monitor or record the call.

**For California Residents:** We will not share information we collect about you with companies outside of the Interfirst Insurance Group LLC family of companies except with your authorization or as permitted by California law, such as to service your account. To authorize the sharing of this information, please call us at 1(847) 999-7283 ask to speak with the Privacy Officer. In addition, we will limit the sharing of information about you within the Interfirst Insurance Group LLC family of companies to the extent required by California law.

**For Vermont Residents:** We will not disclose information about your creditworthiness to affiliates and will not disclose your personal information, financial information, credit report, or health information to nonaffiliated third parties to market to you, other than as permitted by Vermont law, unless you authorize us to make those disclosures.
